

What to Expect at Your Pre-Op Appointment

Now that you are on the schedule, the following information will guide you through your next steps.

At your Pre-Op, we will:

- Sign consent forms.
- Take any necessary preoperative photographs.
- Discuss necessity for any post-operative garments.
- Obtain a current height and weight.
- Go over prescriptions.
- Instruct you regarding what medications and vitamins to avoid prior to surgery.
- Review how and when to pay anesthesia and facility fees.
- Collect remaining fees of Dr. Wendel's portion.

Bring the Following to your Pre-Op:

- A list of questions that you would like answered.
- Current Medication List.
- Method of Payment: We accept all major Debit/Credit Cards, Cash, Cashier's Check, CareCredit, and personal checks from established surgery patients only. We do not accept Health Savings Accounts (HSA).***
 - *Person with name on card has to be present at the time of payment or card must be on file for payment taken over the phone.
 - *If paying with your debit card, your daily limit may need to be increased. Please contact your bank prior to your pre-op appointment to let them know the amount to be processed (Note: charge will be processed by Crestmoor Surgical Associates).

At your Pre-Op you will be given:

- Confirmation of the date and time of surgery.
- A personalized pre-op packet, detailing how to prepare and what to expect during and after your procedure(s).
- Instructions detailing how and when to pay surgical facility and anesthesia charges.
- Directions to the surgical facility.
- Consent forms.

Your Pre-Op is an opportunity to:

- Answer all questions and concerns regarding your procedure(s).
- Provide you with prescriptions needed after your surgery.
- Schedule your first postoperative follow up appointment.

<u>Please Note</u>: If a refill is required on any narcotic pain medication, a written prescription is required and may not be phoned into any pharmacy. This is a requirement from the government.
